



When Lynn arrived in California, she settled down in Santa Cruz and realized her dream of becoming a full-time artist. She continues to travel in between art shows and has developed a unique style, informed by her colorful, cultural experiences. She has also been enriched by the mesmerizing, illuminated and kinetic art found at Burning Man, a yearly festival in the Nevada desert.

Lynn paints Dynamic Landscapes in oil on canvas that are full of joyful energy, vibrant hues and movement. Her work has won many awards and is collected worldwide. Lynn calls this exuberant style Dynamism.


I consider myself a visual storyteller. I voice my stories by painting on canvases and by captured images using my camera. My inspiration comes from the world around me as well as the world inside

my head. As a self-taught artist from a young age, I've experimented with a vast array of styles, techniques and materials to create original art. 20 years. His biggest inspiration is

Ash's work focuses on the integration of mixed media. Pieces often start with a carefully selected collage of newspaper scraps, magazine








